Our Health and Safety Policy Statement

We are continually striving to be recognised as a good employer both internally and externally and we will ensure the health and safety at work of all of our colleagues and any other people who may be affected by our work activities. We will comply with all relevant legislation, regulations and other requirements that are applicable to our business activities.

This policy reflects Company Shop's commitment to ensuring that health and safety at work is paramount to our business and that effective health and safety contributes to our success.

Progress against our commitment will be regularly and openly measured through targets and objectives which are set to allow the monitoring and continual improvement of management and performance of this management system.

1. Awareness – everyone has awareness and understanding of health and safety hazards and risks that affect our business. This includes this policy, open communication and consultation with all colleagues, defined management roles and responsibilities, and the identification of our workplace health and safety hazards.
2. Competence – everyone will have the competence to undertake their work with minimum risks to health and safety. This includes effective work place training and instruction, positive health and safety behaviour and culture, and robust risk assessment and management of those risks.
3. Compliance – Our work activities achieve compliance with applicable or relevant legislation and our colleagues are empowered to take action to minimise health and safety risks. This includes incident investigation, measuring performance, implementing a robust health and safety management system, effective engagement and collaboration with contractors and other interested parties.

We will deliver our policy through generating a culture that does not tolerate threats to health and safety and by ensuring the real involvement of colleagues and all customers/visitors.

This policy has been created to define, endorse and demonstrate our commitment to the Health, Safety and Wellbeing of all of our colleagues and any other people who may be affected by our work activities. The operation of this policy and associated procedures will be monitored and reviewed as necessary, but at least on an annual basis.

Directors, Senior Leaders, Departmental Management and Supervisory colleagues shall have responsibilities for the implementation and maintenance of this policy and must ensure that Health, Safety and Wellbeing issues are given adequate consideration in all planning and activities.
